Keith Smith simplified bookbinding by eliminating the need to pare leather or sew endbands. Using only leather, paper, and thread, you will work through nine three-section bindings based on his work. Each binding involves sewing pages directly through a leather cover to create decorative patterns on the spine, as well as the flexibility to allow these books to open completely flat. Through detailed handouts and resource lists, you'll leave this workshop with the basic knowledge of bookbinding techniques and nine completed books.

About the Instructor

Elissa Campbell has been making books for the past twenty-four years and works out of her studio in Montpelier, Vermont. She is a big believer in the power of using books for self expression - she received her MA in Expressive Therapies with a concentration in Art Therapy from Lesley University and her experience drives her to create objects that allow people to tell their stories. She has been teaching bookbinding workshops for 8.5 years and is currently acting as co-chair of the Book Arts Guild of Vermont.
